Double vision, or "seeing double," occurs when two nonmatching images are sent to the part of the brain that is responsible for processing visual input. If this occurs over the long term, the brain will eventually compensate for the two signals by suppressing one signal, so that a single image is perceived.

Double vision occurs when the brain cannot combine the images from each of the eyes into a single image. This is usually because the images are not similar enough, because of problems with the muscles or nerves that control precisely where each eye is looking. There are two main types of double vision – binocular and monocular.

Double vision can also be a symptom of a stroke, an aneurysm, or head or facial trauma, especially around the eye socket. Sometimes, binocular double vision becomes apparent only when a person moves the eyes in a certain direction, such as up or down or far to the left or right.

Diplopia is the simultaneous perception of two images of a single object that may be displaced horizontally, vertically, diagonally (i.e., both vertically and horizontally), or rotationally in relation to each other. Also called double vision, it is a loss of visual focus under regular conditions, and is almost often voluntary.
