The Clinical Human Factors Group is a broad coalition of healthcare professionals, managers and service users who have partnered with experts in human factors from healthcare and other high-risk industries to campaign for a healthcare system that places an understanding of human factors at the heart of improving clinical, managerial and organisational practice.

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The human factors approach to patient safety, derived from aviation, has been widely used in healthcare, including the emergency department.
