Here we will briefly summarise the voyage. Departing England in July 1768, Lieutenant James Cook in charge of HM Bark Endeavour sailed to Tahiti. Endeavour reached the island after a voyage of eight months, during which none of its crew had succumbed to the disease scurvy, which was most unusual for the times.
