If you don't have a Cricut machine, you can still make your own freezer paper stencils. Freezer paper is VERY easy to cut with a sharp Craft knife (like the TrueControl Knife pictured above). I prefer the ones with a comfort grip. Use it with a cutting mat for best results. If you are cutting out your design with a knife, you can run the freezer paper through your printer (paper side up) and cut it out.

cut to size, you can iron your fabric to it. Place the wrong side of the fabric on the waxed side of the paper. Use the hottest setting your fabric can take, and, with a dry iron, press the fabric to the freezer paper.

How to Make Printable Fabric Using Freezer Paper

Trace whatever shape you'd like to use onto the freezer paper. Freezer paper has a shiny side and a duller side. It's easier to trace onto the duller side. Use an X-Acto blade to cut the shape out of freezer paper. Leave plenty of "extra" paper around the edges. This extra paper will get ironed right into the shirt and serve to keep it free and clear of wandering painted fingerprints.

Freezer Paper; Ink Jet Printer; Fabric (Canvas and Cotton Work best) Image of choice; Tape or glue; Directions: Cut a piece of freezer paper to 8.5" by 11", or use the already precut and sized freezer paper made for printers and glue or tape it to your card stock shiny side up. The cardstock will help stabilize the freezer paper so it doesn't get jammed in your printer or smear the ink when it doesn't pull properly from a slippery sheet of freezer paper.

Cut a piece of fabric and a sheet of freezer paper that are both 8.5 by 11 inches. Set your iron to the dry and high setting, lay the fabric on top of the freezer paper, and make sure the shiny side of the freezer paper is facing the fabric. Iron the fabric smoothly onto the freezer paper so they adhere.

First, tape the design to the back (waxy side) of a sheet of freezer paper, so it wont slip. Next, trace the design onto the non-waxy side of the freezer paper. It helps to have a light box, but I'm cheap so I go without one.
